




They have struggled through centuries to preserve their language and their Christian faith against all kinds of invaders and against communism.

The city of Făgăraş, firstly documentary certified in 1291, numbers around 30,000 inhabitants. Situated at half distance between Brasov and Sibiu, it is the economical and cultural centre of the region.











It is here in Făgăraş that our school is located, an educational institution with tradition, that this year, 2012, celebrates its 50th anniversary. In this entire period the school has developed and has managed to meet the needs and trends of the local community.





The total number of students in our school is about 1000, divided into 39 classes as follows:

- Technology High School day courses: 684 students aged 15 – 19, divided into 37 classes
- Technology High School evening courses: 79 students aged 18 40, distributed into 3 classes
- -Low-frequency High School: 149 students aged 18 45, divided into 5 classes
- -- Post High School College: 70 students aged 20 45, divided into 3 classes.







After finishing high school, students can continue studies in the Post High-School College run by our school, "AV. DR. Ioan Şenchea College" in Făgăraş. Students obtain advanced (level 3) qualifications as a cadastral landed agent, auto-electro technician, mountain tourism technician.







The fields of training in our school are:
Agriculture, Mechanics, Tourism and
Catering, Economic, Food Industry,
Environmental Protection.







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Since our board of teachers consider the saying: "All work and no play makes Jack a dull boy" to be a true one, in our school students acquire knowledge by a wide range of extra-curricular and extraschool activities:







The "Viceversa Day" – when students become teachers and teachers become students, an activity that is very inspiring and funny for us.
