


What is **EPM** Magazine?





Voting Rules

2. A valid email address is requested to validate the vote;

Scores are assigned according to:

- **2** scores, if the vote is given by a person who comes from the same nation of the article author;
- **3** scores, if the vote is given by a person of a different nation of the article author


EPM Award 2009/2010
